

HJR 55 -- Constitutional Amendments

Currently, a proposed constitutional amendment takes effect at the end of 30 days after the election if a majority of the votes cast are in favor of the amendment. Upon voter approval, this proposed constitutional requires a majority of the votes cast statewide and a majority of the votes cast in each of a majority of the Congressional districts to be in favor of the amendment in order for it to take effect.
