

SB 564 -- MOTORCYCLE RIDER TRAINING

SPONSOR: Brown (Davis)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "do pass" by the Committee on Transportation by a vote of 11 to 0.

This bill specifies that the successful completion of a military motorcycle rider training course that meets or exceeds the Motorcycle Safety Foundation curriculum standards by an applicant who is an active member of the United States armed forces must constitute an actual demonstration of the person's ability to exercise due care in the operation of a motorcycle or motortricycle and that no further driving test can be required to obtain a motorcycle or motortricycle license or endorsement.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on state funds in FY 2013, FY 2014, and FY 2015.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that the military training is as comprehensive as what we need to require.

Testifying for the bill was Senator Brown.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
