

HCS SB 578 -- STATE PROPERTY

SPONSOR: Parson (Cox)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "do pass" by the Committee on Local Government by a vote of 13 to 0.

This substitute designates the portion of Interstate 64/U.S. Route 40 in St. Charles County from mile marker 10.2 to mile marker 12.8 as the "Darrell B. Roegner Memorial Highway." The costs for the designation are to be paid by private donations.

The substitute also authorizes the Governor to vacate an easement between the state and the City of Sedalia located at 2600 West 16th Street and grant the city an easement to construct and operate a fire station and an entrance on and over certain state-owned property and to convey specified state property located in Pike, Macon, DeKalb, Jackson, Johnson, Howell, Ozark, Dallas, St. Clair, St. Louis, and Bates counties to the State Highways and Transportation Commission.

FISCAL NOTE: No impact on state funds in FY 2013, FY 2014, and FY 2015.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that the new easement is necessary because the City of Sedalia needs to build a new fire station.

Testifying for the bill was Senator Parson.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
