1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for Senate Substitute for Senate Committee Substitute for
2 Senate Bill No. 125, Page 15, Section 161.092, Line 68, by inserting after all of said line the
3 following:

4 "161.855. 1. The department of elementary and secondary education shall conduct at least
5 one public hearing in each congressional district in Missouri prior to the full implementation of the
6 common core state standards. The public hearings shall provide an opportunity for members of the
7 general public to publicly testify regarding the common core state standards. The department shall
8 provide each person who wishes to testify at a public hearing a reasonable amount of time to do so.
9 The commissioner of education and at least one member of the state board of education shall attend
10 each public hearing. The commissioner of education shall be excused from attending a public
11 hearing only for extenuating circumstances. The department of elementary and secondary education
12 shall publish a notice on its internet website at least two weeks prior to each of the public hearings
13 and post such notice at the location of each public hearing. At such time, the department shall also
14 notify each district of the public hearing that shall take place in the congressional district in which
15 the district is located. Within seventy-two hours of receiving the department's notification, each
16 district shall notify parents, in a manner in which it chooses, of the public hearing that shall take
17 place in the congressional district in which the district is located.

18 2. At least two weeks prior to the first of the public hearings, the department of elementary
19 and secondary education shall perform and make publicly available a fiscal analysis of the projected
20 cost to the state and school districts of the implementation of the common core state standards. The
21 analysis shall include the costs of material, equipment, technology, and training, as well as any
22 savings that may be realized. The department shall provide the fiscal analysis to the president pro
23 tempore of the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, and to the joint committee on
24 education. The department shall publish the fiscal analysis on its internet website.

25 3. At least two weeks prior to the first of the public hearings, the department of elementary
26 and secondary education shall prepare a report that identifies:

27 (1) Any data that shall be collected as a result of the implementation of the common core
28 state standards; and

29 (2) Any governmental entity, quasi-governmental entity, or consortium that collects data or
30 receives data as a result of the implementation of the common core state standards.

31 4. The department of elementary and secondary education shall submit the report required

1 under subsection 3 of this section to the president pro tempore of the senate, the speaker of the house
2 of representatives, and to the joint committee on education. The department shall publish the report
3 on its internet website. The department shall notify parents of public school students of the data
4 collection procedures described in subsection 3 of this section.

5 5. The department of elementary and secondary education shall conduct all of the public
6 hearings by December 31, 2013.

7 6. By January 31, 2014, the department shall provide a report to the president pro tempore of
8 the senate, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the joint committee on education that
9 summarizes the public testimony heard at each of the public hearings." ; and

11 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
12 accordingly.
