AN ACT

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the use of tobacco in a private business.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 191.778, to read as follows:

3 **191.778. If any political subdivision prohibits the use of tobacco in a private**
2 **business under section 191.777, all tax revenue generated by the business through property**
3 **taxes and county sales taxes shall be remitted to the local school district in lieu of the**
4 **political subdivision.**
