

HB 71 -- Motor Vehicle Fee Office Charges

This bill changes the amount a motor vehicle fee office that receives no compensation from the Department of Revenue is authorized to collect for certain services. The bill:

(1) Increases, from \$3.50 to \$5.00, the fee for each motor vehicle or trailer registration issued, renewed, or transferred and increases, from \$7.00 to \$10.00, the fee for a biennially sold or renewed license;

(2) Increases, from \$2.50 to \$5.00, the fee for an application or transfer of title;

(3) Increases, from \$2.50 to \$5.00, the fee for each address change; instruction permit; nondriver license; chauffeur's, operator's, or driver's license issued for a period of three years or less and increases, from \$5.00 to \$10.00, the fee for a license or instruction permit issued or renewed for a period exceeding three years ; and

(4) Increases, from \$2.50 to \$5.00, the fee for each processed notice of lien.
