HB 89 -- Firearm Responsibility Act

Sponsor: Colona

This bill establishes the Firearm Responsibility Act which specifies that a person commits the crime of failure to secure a firearm, a class A misdemeanor, if he or she fails to secure a firearm at all times when the firearm is not in active use by the engagement of a gun locking device, as defined in the bill, or storage in a locked safe, gun box, or other appropriate similar container.

These provisions do not apply to any licensed law enforcement or peace officer or active member of the United States Armed Forces.
