

HB 317 -- Children's Vaccinations

This bill establishes Molly's Law which requires a licensed health care practitioner, administering a vaccination to a child less than seven years of age, to provide the list of ingredients contained in the vaccination and how to obtain additional information on the ingredients to the parent or guardian of the child. The list of ingredients must be provided by the manufacturer of the vaccine.

The health care practitioner must document in the child's medical records that the parent or legal guardian was provided the ingredient list prior to the vaccination being administered.
