HB 640 -- Purchase of Firearms

Sponsor: Parkinson

This bill specifies that a federally licensed firearms dealer must conduct a federal background check and sell a firearm to a person who presents a form of identification that is issued by the federal government, the state, or a local election authority; issued by a state institution of higher education; a copy of a current utility bill, bank statement, paycheck, government check, or other government document containing the name and address of the person; a driver's license or state identification card issued by another state; or an attestation from two or more federally licensed firearms dealers that they know the person.
