HB 655 -- Motorcycle Instruction Permits

Sponsor: Hurst

This bill allows a person who has been issued a temporary motorcycle instruction permit to renew the permit two additional times for a total maximum period of 18 months.

Currently, specified restrictions are placed on temporary motorcycle instruction permit holders who are under 16 years of age. The bill makes the specified restrictions apply to every permit holder regardless of age and repeals the restrictions regarding the limitation on the engine size and an operator not being able to travel more than 50 miles from the operator's home address.
