HB 659 -- Licensure Requirements for Certain Professions

Sponsor: Marshall

This bill authorizes a person to engage in the practice of certain professions without being licensed if the person does not hold himself or herself out as being licensed. These professions include geologists, boxing or wrestling contestants, massage therapists, interior designers, private investigators or private fire investigators, landscape architects, barbers, cosmetologists and cosmetology school operators, embalmers, and athlete agents. Any person who violates these provisions will be guilty of a class C misdemeanor.
