

HJR 35 -- Right to Keep and Bear Arms

Sponsor: Jones (50)

Upon voter approval, this constitutional amendment adds that a citizen has the right to keep and bear arms in defense of his or her family to the current rights in defense of a citizen's home, person and property. The amendment repeals the provision stating that the right must not justify the wearing of a concealed weapon. Finally, the amendment reaffirms that the right to keep and bear arms is unalienable. The state is obligated to uphold the right and must, under no circumstances, decline to protect against its infringement.
