1 AMEND Senate Bill No. 628, Page 1, In the Title, Lines 3 and 4, by deleting the words "the transfer
2 of property by the governing bodies of certain"; and
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4 Further amend said bill, Page 1, In the Title, Line 4, by inserting after the word "clause" the words
5 "for a certain section"; and
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7 Further amend said bill, Page 5, Section 37.005, Line 159, by inserting after all of said line the
8 following:

9 "173.1110. 1. No covered student unlawfully present in the United States shall receive a
10 postsecondary education public benefit. Educational institutions awarding postsecondary education
11 public benefits to covered students shall verify that these students are United States citizens,
12 permanent residents, or lawfully present in the United States.

13 2. The following documents, in hard copy or electronic form, may be used to document that
14 a covered student is a United States citizen, permanent resident, or is lawfully present in the United
15 States:

- 16 (1) The Free Application for Student Aid Institutional Student Information Record;
17 (2) A state-issued driver's license;
18 (3) A state-issued nondriver's identification card;
19 (4) Documentary evidence recognized by the department of revenue when processing an
20 application for a driver's license or nondriver's identification card;
21 (5) A United States birth certificate;
22 (6) A United States military identification card; or
23 (7) Any document issued by the federal government that confirms an alien's lawful presence
24 in the United States.

25 3. All postsecondary higher education institutions shall annually certify to the department of
26 higher education that they have not knowingly awarded a postsecondary education public benefit to a
27 covered student who is unlawfully present in the United States.

28 4. As used in this section, the following terms shall mean:

29 (1) "Covered student", a student eighteen years of age or older, who has graduated from high
30 school and is attending classes on the campus of a postsecondary educational institution during
31 regularly scheduled academic sessions;

32 (2) "Postsecondary education public benefit", institutional financial aid awarded by public
33 postsecondary educational institutions and state-administered postsecondary grants and scholarships
34 awarded by all postsecondary educational institutions to covered students;

35 (3) "Unlawfully present", includes a covered student whose removal has been deferred
36 through the June 15, 2012, executive order commonly referred to as deferred action for childhood

1 arrival or whose removal has been or is deferred by any past or future executive order or federal law.

2 173.1112. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, no public institution of higher
3 education located within this state shall offer a tuition rate to a covered student who is unlawfully
4 present in the United States, as such terms are defined in section 173.1110, that is less than the tuition
5 rate charged to citizens or nationals of the United States whose residence is not in Missouri. When a
6 public institution of higher education sets a separate tuition rate for international students, such
7 students shall be charged the same tuition rate as international students.

8 2. No powers, assets, employees, agents, or contractors of the state, any political subdivision,
9 municipality, or other local government entity, or any public institution of higher education located
10 within this state, shall be used to assist in implementing any federal or state executive order which is
11 in conflict with the provisions of subsection 1 of this section."; and

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13 Further amend said bill, Page 6, Section B, Lines 1 to 6, by deleting all of said lines and inserting in
14 lieu thereof the following:

15 "Section B. Because of the importance of allowing higher education institutions to provide
16 responses to property lessors in a timely manner, the repeal and reenactment of section 37.005 of this
17 act is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the public health, welfare, peace, and
18 safety, and the repeal and reenactment of section 37.005 of this act is hereby declared to be an
19 emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and the repeal and reenactment of section
20 37.005 of this act shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval."; and

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22 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
23 accordingly.
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
