1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1655, Page 1, in the Title, Lines 2-3, by  
2 deleting the words "the operation of motorcycles or motortricycles" and inserting in lieu thereof the  
3 words "motor vehicles"; and

4  
5 Further amend said bill, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting immediately after said line the  
6 following:

8 "301.3083. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any person, after  
9 an annual payment of an emblem-use fee to the Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks, may  
10 receive special license plates for any vehicle the person owns, either solely or jointly, other than an  
11 apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle licensed in excess of eighteen thousand  
12 pounds gross weight. The Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks hereby authorizes the use of its  
13 official emblem to be affixed on multiyear personalized license plates as provided in this section.  
14 Any contribution to the Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks derived from this section, except  
15 reasonable administrative costs, shall be used solely for the purposes of the Breast Cancer  
16 Foundation of the Ozarks. Any member of the Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks may annually  
17 apply for the use of the emblem.

18 2. Upon annual application and payment of a twenty-five dollar emblem-use contribution to  
19 the Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks, the Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks shall issue  
20 to the vehicle owner, without further charge, an emblem-use authorization statement, which shall be  
21 presented by the vehicle owner to the director of revenue at the time of registration. Upon  
22 presentation of the annual statement and payment of a twenty-five dollar fee in addition to the  
23 regular registration fees, and presentation of any documents which may be required by law, the  
24 director of revenue shall issue to the vehicle owner a special license plate which shall bear the  
25 emblem of the Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks. Such license plates shall be made with fully  
26 reflective material with a common color scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and  
27 shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130. In addition, upon such set of  
28 license plates shall be inscribed, in lieu of the words "SHOW-ME STATE", the words "BCFO.ORG".  
29 Notwithstanding the provisions of section 301.144, no additional fee shall be charged for the  
30 personalization of license plates issued pursuant to this section.

31 3. A vehicle owner who was previously issued a plate with the Breast Cancer Foundation of  
32 the Ozarks emblem authorized by this section, but who does not provide an emblem-use  
33 authorization statement at a subsequent time of registration, shall be issued a new plate which does  
34 not bear the Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks emblem, as otherwise provided by law. The  
35 director of revenue shall make necessary rules and regulations for the enforcement of this section,  
36 and shall design all necessary forms required by this section.

1           4. Prior to the issuance of a Breast Cancer Foundation of the Ozarks specialty plate  
2 authorized under this section the department of revenue must be in receipt of an application, as  
3 prescribed by the director, which shall be accompanied by a list of at least two hundred potential  
4 applicants who plan to purchase the specialty plate, the proposed art design for the specialty license  
5 plate, and an application fee, not to exceed five thousand dollars, to defray the department's cost for  
6 issuing, developing, and programming the implementation of the specialty plate. Once the plate  
7 design is approved, the director of revenue shall not authorize the manufacture of the material to  
8 produce such specialized license plates with the individual seal, logo, or emblem until such time as  
9 the director has received two hundred applications, the twenty-five dollar specialty plate fee per  
10 application, and emblem-use statements, if applicable, and other required documents or fees for such  
11 plates."; and

13 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
14 accordingly.
