AN ACT

To amend chapter 44, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to personal identifying information in disasters or emergencies.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 44, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 44.035, to read as follows:

3 **44.035. No name, address, social security number, or any other personal identifying**
4 **information used in a voluntary registry of persons with health-related ailments that is**
5 **created by a public governmental body to assist individuals in case of a disaster or**
6 **emergency shall be deemed a public record under chapter 610. Nothing in this section**
7 **shall be construed to authorize a public governmental body to deny a lawful request for**
8 **such name, address, social security number, or other personal identifying information from**
9 **a law enforcement agency or any public governmental body that provides fire fighting,**
10 **medical, or other emergency services.**
