

HB 1388 -- ELECTRONIC LOCATION DEVICES (Cornejo)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Committee on Downsizing State Government

This bill prohibits a governmental entity from obtaining the location information of an electronic device without a search warrant, except in certain specified circumstances. Any evidence obtained as a result of a violation of these provisions is inadmissible in a civil, criminal, or administrative proceeding and cannot be used in an affidavit of probable cause to obtain a search warrant. A person who violates these provisions is subject to a \$50 fine.
