

HB 1426 -- PERSONAL IDENTIFYING INFORMATION IN DISASTERS OR
EMERGENCIES

SPONSOR: Diehl

This bill prohibits the name, address, Social Security number, or any other personal identifying information compiled by a public governmental body for use in a voluntary registry of persons with health-related ailments for the purpose of assisting individuals in case of a disaster or emergency from being considered a public record under Chapter 610, RSMo, the Open Meetings and Records Law which is commonly known as the Sunshine Law. The provisions of the bill must not be construed to authorize a public governmental body to deny a lawful request for the information from a law enforcement agency or any public governmental body that provides fire fighting, medical, or other emergency services.
