AN ACT

To repeal section 311.730, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof three new sections relating to public safety.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 311.730, RSMo, is repealed and three new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as sections 311.730, 311.735, and 1, to read as follows:

311.730. **1. Except as otherwise provided under subsection 2 of this section,** all fees collected by the director of revenue as provided for in this chapter, including licenses, inspection and gauging fees, shall be paid into the state treasury, to the credit of the ordinary state revenue fund.

2. Seventy percent of all fees for licenses and permits collected under this chapter shall be paid to the credit of the division of alcohol and tobacco control fund established under section 311.735.

311.735. 1. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control Fund". The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, money in the fund shall be used solely by the division of alcohol and tobacco control for the administration of this chapter and sections 407.925 to 407.934, and any duties under such chapter and sections relating to licensing, training, technical assistance, and regulations.

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund.

11 **3. Appropriation of funds by the general assembly from the fund shall be used to**
12 **support the division of alcohol and tobacco control for the purposes provided under**
13 **subsection 1 of this section.**

Section 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, any
2 **individual who holds an occupational license issued by the Missouri gaming commission**
3 **as an unarmed security guard, serving on an excursion gambling boat or a facility adjacent**
4 **to such boat, shall be exempt from any other political subdivision's licensing requirements**
5 **for unarmed security guards. No such individual shall be subject to multiple standards for**
6 **regulating unarmed security guards in areas subject to regulation by the Missouri gaming**
7 **commission. The commission shall have sole authority to license and regulate unarmed**
8 **security guards on excursion gambling boats and adjacent facilities.**

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
