AN ACT

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to transfer student test scores.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 167.890, to read as follows:

2 **167.890. 1. The department of elementary and secondary education shall prepare**
3 **and maintain an easy-to-search database containing student statewide assessment scores**
4 **of all transfer students enrolled in districts other than a student's resident district as**
5 **provided in section 167.131. Each transfer student shall be assigned a random**
6 **identification number by the department for purposes of the database and no personally**

7 **2. The department of elementary and secondary education may promulgate all**
8 **necessary rules and regulations for the administration of this section. Any rule or portion**
9 **of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority**
10 **delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all**
11 **of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and**
12 **chapter 536 are nonseverable and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly**
13 **pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul**
14 **a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and**
15 **any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2015, shall be invalid and void.**
