AN ACT

To repeal section 115.513, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to evidence of election fraud.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 115.513, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 115.513, to read as follows:

115.513. If any verification board, bipartisan committee, election authority or the secretary of state obtains evidence of fraud or any violation of law during a verification, it shall present such evidence immediately to the proper authorities. **If requested by the investigating authorities, a particular description of the facts establishing probable cause to believe that fraud has occurred shall also be provided.**
