AN ACT

To amend chapter 590, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to police department operations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 590, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 590.1000, to read as follows:

3 **590.1000. If the Department of Justice or the United States Attorney General issues**
4 **a report with findings that a police department has engaged in unconstitutional police**
5 **practices, including racial profiling, and such report offers recommendations, the Missouri**
6 **highway patrol or other accredited police department shall have the authority to take over**
7 **operations of such police department if such police department does not implement the**
8 **recommendations issued by the Department of Justice or the United States Attorney**
9 **General.**
