

# House Concurrent Resolution No. 46

## 98TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

2 **WHEREAS**, Section 29.351 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri provides that during the  
3 regular legislative session which convenes in an odd-numbered year, the General Assembly shall,  
4 by concurrent resolution, employ an independent certified public accountant or certified public  
5 accounting firm to conduct an audit examination of the accounts, functions, programs, and  
6 management of the State Auditor's office:

7 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of  
8 Representatives of the Ninety-eighth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate  
9 concurring therein, hereby authorize the employment of an independent certified public  
10 accountant or certified public accounting firm pursuant to the provisions of Section 29.351; and

12 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the audit examination be made in accordance with  
13 generally accepted auditing standards, including such reviews and inspections of books, records,  
14 and other underlying data and documents as are necessary to enable the independent certified  
15 public accountant performing the audit to reach an informed opinion on the condition and  
16 performance of the accounts, functions, programs, and management of the State Auditor's Office;

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that upon completion of the audit, the independent  
20 certified public accountant make a written report of his or her findings and conclusions and  
21 supply each member of the General Assembly, the Governor, and the State Auditor with a copy  
22 of the report; and

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the cost of the audit and report be paid out of the  
25 joint contingent fund of the General Assembly; and

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Commissioner of Administration bid these  
28 services, at the direction of the General Assembly, pursuant to state purchasing laws; and

30 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of  
31 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the  
32 Commissioner of Administration.
