

HCS HBs 35 & 323 -- LICENSING OF CAMPERS AND TRAILERS (Walker)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Transportation

This bill allows a camping or fifth-wheel trailer that is more than 25 years old to be permanently registered upon payment of a \$25 registration fee. Any person possessing a license plate that is more than 25 years old in which the year of issuance of the plate matches the year the camper or trailer was manufactured may register the plate as a historic trailer plate if the configuration of letters and numbers have not already been issued to someone else. The owner of the historic trailer must keep the certificate of registration in the trailer at all times. Upon the transfer of the title, the registration must be canceled and the plate returned to the Director of the Department of Revenue.
