

HB 210 -- COMMUNITY COLLEGE POLICE OFFICERS

SPONSOR: Conway (104)

COMMITTEE ACTIONS: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Public Safety and Emergency Preparedness by a vote of 10 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Select Committee on State and Local Governments by a vote of 10 to 0.

Currently, the board of regents or board of governors of any state college or university may establish regulations to control vehicular traffic on any thoroughfare owned or maintained by the state college or university. This bill allows community college police officers to establish regulations to control vehicular traffic on any thoroughfare owned or maintained by the community college.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that the bill will allow community colleges to establish campus police to regulate the traffic on community college campuses.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Conway (104).

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
