

HB 218 -- LAW ENFORCEMENT AGENCIES (Wilson)

COMMITTEE OF ORIGIN: Standing Committee on Public Safety and

Currently, a sheriff may expressly request the assistance of any sheriff or deputy sheriff of an adjoining county and the sheriff or deputy has the same powers of arrest in that county as he or she has in his or her own jurisdiction. This bill allows a sheriff to expressly request the assistance of any sheriff or deputy sheriff in Missouri. The county where the sheriff or deputy sheriff rendering assistance is employed must be responsible for workers' compensation insurance, overtime, expense reimbursement, and any and all other liability incurred as part of providing assistance in the requesting county.
