

HB 421 -- MOTOR VEHICLE INFORMATION

SPONSOR: Burlison

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Civil and Criminal Proceedings by a vote of 9 to 3.

This bill prohibits the Department of Revenue from sharing motor vehicle information with any out-of-state entity for the purpose of enforcing a civil fine arising from a red light camera or speed camera violation.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that outside of Missouri, local and state governments are using red light and speed camera tickets to raise revenue at the expense of Missouri motorists. This bill protects Missouri motorists by preventing the Department of Revenue from providing other state and local governments with the information needed to enforce the tickets.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Burlison.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
