

HB 464 -- UNIVERSITY OF MISSOURI CURATORS

SPONSOR: Rowden

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Higher Education by a vote of 12 to 0. Voted "Do Pass" by the Select Committee on Education by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill prohibits any member of the University of Missouri Board of Curators from voting to appoint to, hire, or employ in any way in any position in the university any person who appointed him or her to the board. Any such vote taken by a curator will be null and void. Any curator who violates this prohibition will immediately forfeit his or her curator position.

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that this bill will ensure the process of governance at the university level and at the state level will not overlap.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Rowden.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
