

HB 703 -- BOARDS OF ELECTION COMMISSIONERS

SPONSOR: Curtman

Currently, the members of a board of election commissioners are appointed by the Governor with the advice and consent of the Senate. Beginning August 28, 2015, this bill requires all board of election commissioners to be elected to a four-year term. The persons initially elected under these provisions must be elected on the authorized election day immediately prior to the expiration of an appointed commissioner's term of office, and all subsequent elections must occur on the general election day.
