

HB 791 -- SPECIAL LICENSE PLATES

This bill allows a person who makes a donation to the Missouri Fraternal Order of Police (MoFOP) to apply for a specialty personalized license plate to honor a fallen law enforcement officer. This plate is available for a solely or jointly owned vehicle provided that it is not an apportioned motor vehicle or a commercial motor vehicle in excess of 18,000 pounds.

To obtain the plate, an applicant must make a donation of at least \$25 per year to the MoFOP. The MoFOP will then issue the applicant proof of the donation. The applicant must then submit the proof of donation as well as an application to the Director of the Department of Revenue, and pay a \$15 fee in addition to the regular registration fee.

Finally, if the person fails to make the required annual donation to the MoFOP, the director will issue the person standard license plates.
