

HB 994 -- PETITION AUDITS OF POLITICAL SUBDIVISIONS

SPONSOR: Bondon

This bill requires the State Auditor to audit any political subdivision of the state if requested to do so by a petition only if it is submitted by a person who resides or owns real property within the boundaries or area of service of the political subdivision within one year from requesting the petition and it is signed by the required percent of qualified voters of the subdivision.

Any person who has signed or allegedly signed the petition may submit a sworn statement to the State Auditor that he did not sign the petition or that he or she wishes to rescind the signature. The statement must be made within 10 days from submission of the petition to the State Auditor. If the statement is timely filed, the signature must be withdrawn and must not count toward the required threshold.
