

HB 1305 -- REGULATORY IMPROVEMENT COMMISSION

SPONSOR: Rowden

This bill establishes the Regulatory Improvement Commission to evaluate and provide recommendations for modification, consolidation, or repeal of regulations. The commission will consist of the following members:

- (1) One member appointed by the Governor who will serve as the chairperson of the commission;
- (2) Two members appointed by the President Pro Tem of the Senate;
- (3) Two members appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate;
- (4) Two members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and
- (5) Two members appointed by the Minority Floor Leader of the House of Representatives.

The commission will evaluate and provide recommendations for modification, consolidation, or repeal of regulations with the aim of reducing compliance costs, encouraging growth and innovation, and improving competitiveness.

The commission must submit a report to the Governor and the General Assembly no later than December 31, 2016 detailing the commission's findings and recommendations. The commission must dissolve after the submission of its report.
