

HJR 12 -- ANTI-COMMANDEERING AMENDMENT

SPONSOR: Brattin

Upon voter approval, this proposed constitutional amendment implements the existing constitutional doctrine of anti-commandeering at the state law level by confirming that this state may restrict the use of its financial resources and its personnel in a manner consistent with protecting the people's freedom and enforcing the system of checks and balances.

If the state passes a law or amendment or otherwise lawfully indicates opposition to a federal regulatory program, then the state and all political subdivisions thereof are prohibited from using any personnel or financial resources to enforce, administer, or cooperate with the designated federal action or program.
