6 105.263. 1. Any employee of the state of Missouri shall be granted ten consecutive work
7 days of paid parental leave for the birth of a child of the employee or because of the finalization of
8 an adoption by the employee of a child who is under two years of age. Such paid parental leave
9 shall be separate from any other type of paid leave granted to such employee.

10 2. An employee eligible to take the paid leave described under subsection 1 of this section
11 shall not be required to use all or any portion of any accrued vacation leave, accrued sick leave, or
12 other type of accrued leave before being allowed to use the paid leave described under subsection 1
13 of this section.

14 3. An employee who intends to take the paid leave described under subsection 1 of this
15 section shall provide reasonable notice of such intent to his or her supervisor.

16 4. The commissioner of administration may promulgate rules as necessary to implement the
17 provisions of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010,
18 that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies
19 with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This
20 section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly
21 pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are
22 subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or
23 adopted after August 28, 2016, shall be invalid and void."; and"; and

29 205.165. 1. The board of trustees of any hospital authorized under subsection 1 of this
30 section and organized under the provisions of sections 205.160 to 205.340 may invest up to fifteen
31 percent of their funds not required for immediate disbursement in obligations or for the operation of
32 the hospital into any mutual fund, in the form of an investment company, in which shareholders
33 combine money to invest in a variety of stocks, bonds, and money-market investments.
