

HB 2083 -- DNA COLLECTION AND RETENTION

SPONSOR: Black

Currently, every individual who is 17 years old or older and is arrested for burglary, sex-related felonies, and certain felonies committed against a person must provide a biological sample for DNA profiling analysis.

This act requires every individual who is 17 years old or older who is arrested for any felony offense to provide a biological sample for DNA profiling.

The bill requires any DNA sample collected to be retained in the state DNA database and specifies the sample cannot be removed from the database for any reason.

This bill is similar to SB 729 (2016).
