

HB 2096 -- HEALTH INSURANCE FOR COLLEGE STUDENT

SPONSOR: Chipman

This bill specifies that any student who shows proof of existing health insurance coverage to a public college or university at any time during the student's enrollment is excused from the payment of any fees, costs, or related expenses imposed for the provision of health care or health insurance.

These provisions do not preclude public colleges and universities from offering health insurance coverage to students who do not have coverage and charging fees for such coverage or from providing student health services and charging fees for those services to undergraduate students who do not have health insurance coverage.

This bill is similar to HB 1331 (2015).
