

HB 2189 -- ELEMENTARY AND SECONDARY EDUCATION

SPONSOR: Curtis

This bill prohibits school districts, schools, and teachers from receiving financial incentives for students' achievement of certain scores on any test. Any school employee who believes that a school district, school, or teacher has violated this prohibition shall report the alleged violation to the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education and shall not be discharged, retaliated against, or receive any adverse action related to the report.

In addition, the Joint Committee on Education shall review rules relating to the elementary and secondary school accreditation process and evaluate schools' compliance with the rules.
