

HB 2265 -- CLEAN ENERGY ACT

SPONSOR: Korman

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Energy and the Environment by a vote of 11 to 1.

This bill specifies that certain improvements of sewer and drinking water installations, repairs, and modifications qualify as energy efficiency improvements for purposes of the Property Assessment Clean Energy Act.

This bill is the same as HB 600 (2015).

PROPOSERS: Supporters say that the bill clarifies that water and wastewater efficiencies are included in the Property Assessment Clean Energy Act. There is a nexus between energy use and providing safe drinking water to customers.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Korman.

OPPOSERS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
