

HB 2338 -- RELATING TO MARIJUANA

SPONSOR: LaFaver

This bill changes the law so that any person possessing or having under his or her control a controlled substance, except 35 grams or less of any synthetic cannabinoid or one pound or less of marijuana, is guilty of a class C felony for an offense committed before January 1, 2016 and a class D felony on or after January 1, 2017.

It will no longer be unlawful for any person 21 years of age or older to possess or have under his or her control one pound of marijuana, or nine or less marijuana plants, provided that such possession or control is not within 2,000 feet of a public or private elementary, vocational, or secondary school.
