

HB 2536 -- EMPLOYMENT LEAVE

SPONSOR: McCreery

This bill creates the "Missouri Earned Family and Medical Leave Program," which provides up to 30 days of wage replacement benefits for employees who take time off of work for family or medical leave. The bill specifies provisions related to benefit limitations, maximum compensation, and procedures for filing claims and appeals.

This bill makes it unlawful for any person to discharge or discriminate against any employee because such employee has intended to apply, has applied, or has received Missouri earned family and medical leave benefits.

This bill is similar to SB 1049 (2016).
