HB 2330 -- BLAKE SNYDER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY

SPONSOR: Beck

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass by Consent" by the Standing Committee on Transportation by a vote of 11 to 0. Voted "Do Pass-Consent" by the Committee on Consent and House Procedure by a vote of 11 to 0.

This bill designates a portion of State Highway 30 in St. Louis County as the "Blake Snyder Memorial Highway."

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that Officer Snyder was tragically killed while responding to a domestic violence situation in St. Louis on October 6, 2016. He achieved many service awards such as "Hero of the Highways" and was known for his dedication to duty and devotion to the welfare of many local citizens.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Beck; Ken Cox; Justin Sparks; Elizabeth Snyder; and Peggy Snyder.

OPPONENTS: There was no opposition voiced to the committee.
