

HB 255 -- EDUCATION GROWTH MODELS

SPONSOR: Brown (70)

This bill defines "growth model" as the use of scores to measure growth of individual students over time, and provides an option that the Missouri School Improvement Plan use either the Statewide System of Assessments or results on multiple standardized formative assessments primarily for the purpose of determining growth and using the growth model to help in determining accreditation classifications.

This bill is similar to HB 1280 (2020) and HB 1059 (2019).
