15	(4) The costs associated with speakers and guests used by a school district in the school
16	district's professional development activities.
17	3. The department of elementary and secondary education shall establish an online form that
18	each school district in this state shall complete with information required under subsection 2 of this
19	section.
20	4. A school district shall submit any updates to the information outlined in subsection 2 of
21	this section every six months. A public school or school district may make good-faith modifications
22	to curricula during each six-month period between updates but shall not be required to submit an
23	update of such modifications until the next six-month update.
24	5. Not less than monthly, the department of elementary and secondary education shall
25	update the tool with the information required by this section to be submitted by each school district
26	and shall ensure that the tool is maintained as the primary centralized source of information about
27	the curriculum and instructional materials used by public school districts.
28	6. The department of elementary and secondary education may promulgate rules to

2	is created under the authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies
3	with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This
4	section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly
5	pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are
6	subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or
7	adopted after August 28, 2022, shall be invalid and void.
