1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 1677, Page 8, Section 376.414, Line 59,  
2 by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "376.687. 1. As used in this section, "prescription insulin drug" means a prescription drug  
5 adjudicated through a pharmacy benefits manager as defined under section 376.387 that contains  
6 insulin and is used to control blood glucose levels to treat diabetes, but does not include an insulin  
7 drug that is administered to a patient intravenously.

8 2. This section applies to any group or individual policy of accident and health insurance  
9 amended, delivered, issued, or renewed on or after August 28, 2022.

10 3. An insurer that provides coverage for prescription insulin drugs under the terms of a  
11 health coverage plan the insurer offers shall limit the total amount that an insured is required to pay  
12 for a thirty-day supply of covered prescription insulin drugs at an amount not to exceed one hundred  
13 dollars, regardless of the quantity or type of covered prescription insulin drug used to fill the  
14 insured's prescription.

15 4. On January first of each year, the limit on the amount that an insured is required to pay  
16 for a thirty-day supply of a covered prescription insulin drug shall increase by a percentage equal to  
17 the percentage change from the preceding year in the medical care component of the Consumer  
18 Price Index of the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States Department of Labor.

19 5. The director of the department of commerce and insurance may promulgate all necessary  
20 rules and regulations for the administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that  
21 term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall  
22 become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if  
23 applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable, and if any of the  
24 powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to review, to delay the effective  
25 date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held unconstitutional, then the grant of  
26 rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after August 28, 2022, shall be invalid and  
27 void.

28 376.689. 1. Before November 2, 2022, the department of commerce and insurance, in  
29 conjunction with the department of health and senior services and the department of social services,  
30 shall make available to the public a report that details each department's findings for the following:

- 1           (1) A summary of insulin pricing practices and variables that contribute to the pricing of  
2 health coverage plans;  
3           (2) Public policy recommendations to control and prevent overpricing of prescription  
4 insulin drugs made available to Missouri consumers; and  
5           (3) Any other information that the department of commerce and insurance finds necessary.  
6           2. The provisions of this section terminate on January 1, 2023."; and
