1 AMEND House Committee Substitute for House Bill No. 2136, Page 4, Section 173.1200, Line 45,
2 by inserting after all of said section and line the following:

4 "338.061. 1. This section shall be known and may be cited as the "Tricia Leann Tharp Act".

5 2. The board of pharmacy shall recommend that all licensed pharmacists who are employed
6 at a licensed retail pharmacy obtain two hours of continuing education in suicide awareness and
7 prevention. Any such board-approved continuing education shall count toward the total hours of
8 continuing education hours required by the board for the renewal of a license under subsection 3 of
9 section 338.060.

10 3. The board of pharmacy shall develop guidelines suitable for training materials that may
11 be used by accredited schools of pharmacy and other organizations and courses approved by the
12 Accreditation Council for Pharmacy Education; except that, schools of pharmacy may approve
13 materials to be used in providing training for faculty and other employees.

14 4. The board of pharmacy may promulgate rules to implement the provisions of this section.
15 Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in section 536.010, that is created under the
16 authority delegated in this section shall become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all
17 of the provisions of chapter 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536
18 are nonseverable, and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536
19 to review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently held
20 unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or adopted after
21 August 28, 2022, shall be invalid and void."; and

23 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references
24 accordingly.
