1 AMEND House Resolution No. 3886, Page 3, Line 73, by deleting the colon ":" and inserting in lieu
2 thereof the following:

5 WHEREAS, Dorrel Norman Elvert "Whitey" Herzog was born on November 9, 1931 in
6 New Athens, Illinois; and

7 WHEREAS, in 1951 he hit a combined .276 for Class-C Joplin and Class-B Piedmont. The
8 next season, 1952, after playing for Quincy in the Three-I League and Beaumont in the Double-A
9 Texas League, he reached Triple A with Kansas City in the American Association. After the season,
10 he was drafted into the US Army and spent two years in the Corps of Engineers; and

11 WHEREAS, the same year Herzog joined the Army, he married his high-school sweetheart,
12 Mary Lou Sinn. They have been married for 69 years and have three children, Debbie, Jim, and
13 David; and

14 WHEREAS, while stationed at Fort Leonard Wood, he got his first experience running a
15 baseball team, when he managed the company baseball team; and

16 WHEREAS, he spent eight years in Major League Baseball as a player, including stints with
17 Washington, Kansas City, Baltimore, and Detroit, as an outfielder-first baseman; and

18 WHEREAS, he managed four different Major League Baseball teams, including five years
19 with the Kansas City Royals from 1975-1979 and over 10 years with the St. Louis Cardinals from
20 1980-1990; and

21 WHEREAS, his 1,281 victories rank 25th on the all-time list for managers in Major League
22 Baseball; and

23 WHEREAS, in his four full seasons as manager for Kansas City, he managed the Royals to
24 three straight division titles and one second place finish; and

25 WHEREAS, in his nine full seasons as manager and general manager for St. Louis, he led
26 the Cardinals to a World Series victory in 1982 and to National League pennants in 1985 and 1987;
27 and

28 WHEREAS, he was named 1985 manager of the year and was twice named executive of the
29 year as general manager; and

30 WHEREAS, he was inducted to the Kansas City Royals Hall of Fame in 2000, to the
31 Missouri Sports Hall of Fame in 2008, to the National Baseball Hall of Fame in 2010, and to the
32 inaugural class of the St. Louis Cardinals Hall of Fame in 2014;" and
