# **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

Officials from the **Office of the State Auditor** assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for this agency.

Officials from the Jackson County Board of Elections, City of Claycomo, City of Kansas City, City of O'Fallon, City of Springfield, Fruitland Area Fire Protection District and the Newton County Health Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

Officials from the **City of Laclede** indicated there would be a fiscal impact; however, they did not provide any additional information.

In response to a similar proposal, HB 1243 (2021), officials from the Lincoln County Assessor's Office, City of Corder, City of Claycomo, City of Kansas City, Kansas City Health Department, Pettis County Ambulance District, Cole Camp Ambulance District, Crawford County 911 Board and the Nodaway County Ambulance District each assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations.

In response to a similar proposal, HB 1243 (2021), officials from the **Clinton County Commissioners' Office** indicated there <u>would be</u> a fiscal impact from this proposal, but did not provide any additional information. Conversely, officials from the **Clinton County Clerk's Office** indicated there <u>would not be</u> a fiscal impact from this proposal.

Based on the majority of responses received, **Oversight** does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this proposal. However, Oversight received a limited number of responses from local political subdivisions related to the fiscal impact of this proposal. Oversight has presented this fiscal note on the best information available. Upon the receipt of additional responses, Oversight will review to determine if an updated fiscal note should be prepared and seek approval to publish a new fiscal note.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local political subdivisions were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not. A listing of political subdivisions included in the Missouri Legislative Information System database is available upon request.
