FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Section 393.1072

Officials from the **Office of the Governor** state this bill adds to the governor's current load of appointment duties. Individually, additional requirements should not fiscally impact the Office of the Governor. However, the cumulative impact of additional appointment duties across all enacted legislation may require additional resources for the Office of the Governor.

Officials from the **Missouri State Senate** anticipate a negative fiscal impact to reimburse 15 members of the task force on Fair, Nondiscriminatory Local Taxation Concerning Solar Energy Systems for travel expenses. It will cost approximately \$1,940.40 per meeting.

Oversight assumes the above agencies can absorb the cost of the Task Force meetings within the current appropriation levels and will not reflect a fiscal impact. If multiple bills pass which require additional staffing and duties at substantial costs, the agencies could request funding through the appropriation process.

In response to a similar proposal, officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives** assumed the proposal would have no fiscal impact on their organization. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for this agency.
