AN ACT

To repeal sections 9.339 and 227.787, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof four new sections relating to state designations.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Sections 9.339 and 227.787, RSMo, are repealed

- 2 and four new sections enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as
- 3 sections 9.339, 227.787, 227.807, and 227.816, to read as
- 4 follows:
 - 9.339. September [22, 2021,] twenty-second each year
- 2 is hereby designated as "Hazel Erby Day" in Missouri.
- 3 Citizens of this state are encouraged to participate in
- 4 appropriate events and activities to recognize Hazel Erby's
- 5 lifelong dedication to public service and community
- 6 improvement.
 - 227.787. The portion of Interstate 70 from Shreve Road
- 2 continuing to Kingshighway Boulevard shall be designated as
- 3 "Captain David Dorn Memorial Highway". The department of
- 4 transportation shall erect and maintain appropriate signs
- 5 designating such highway, with the costs to be paid by
- 6 private donations.
 - 227.807. The bridge on U.S. Highway 54 crossing the
- 2 Missouri River at Jefferson City in Cole and Callaway
- 3 counties shall be designated the "Senator Roy Blunt
- 4 Bridge". The department of transportation shall erect and

- 4 department of transportation shall erect and maintain
