HB 1554 -- CURRICULUM AND INSTRUCTION IN PUBLIC SCHOOLS

SPONSOR: Gregory (96)

This bill defines "local educational agency" and "public school" and prohibits specified concepts outlined in the bill from being part of a course of instruction, in a curriculum, or instructional program, and prohibits the use of materials that include or promote such concepts.

The bill prohibits local education agencies and public schools from accepting money, grants or gifts related to the specified concepts or developing their own materials. The Department of Elementary and Secondary Education is given authority to withhold money from any local education agency's or public school's state formula funding if they are determined to be in violation of the prohibitions.
