HB 2051 -- MISSOURI MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

SPONSOR: Schroer

This bill creates the "Missouri Motor Vehicle Commission" within the Department of Revenue, and transfers to it the Department's powers and duties regarding the licensing of vehicle dealers.

The Missouri Motor Vehicle Commission shall consist of seven members appointed by the Governor and confirmed with the advice and consent of the Senate. The bill sets out member qualifications, initial membership terms, authority to adopt an official seal, the process for the election of a chair and secretary, and for the employment of an executive director and other staff as the Commission deems necessary. The bill requires the Commission and the Director of the Department of Revenue to cooperate as necessary to implement the provisions of the bill.

This bill is the same as SB 971 (2022).
